



IBM U2TechConnect Announces Login Changes

Beginning in December 2008, IBM U2TechConnect will require all users to log in using an IBM Profile User ID and Password. This is the same User ID and Password used for other IBM sites like developerWorks and the Support Knowledgebase.

Benefits

- Fewer passwords to remember
- IBM User ID/password is self-maintained - if you forget your password, you can reset it yourself
- The IBM User ID/password never expires (unless you are located in Italy)
- Allows for single sign-on into the U2TC/U2BC system
- Improved security
